Twitter Assignment

We will use the social networking service *Twitter* (www.twitter.com) as one form of communication for this class. We will use Twitter for informal class discussions, reminders, updates and to exchange information relevant to class topics. We will also use Twitter for submission of homework. You are required to maintain a Twitter account for this class.

- If you already have a Twitter account it is preferable that you use that account for this class.

If you do not have a Twitter account, or would prefer to maintain a separate account for this class, then you will create a new Twitter account.

In either case, "private accounts" are not acceptable as your instructor will not be able to receive your "Tweets."

Please note that "egg accounts," are not acceptable for this class; please create an account with any kind of profile photo. It is not necessary to use your own photo as your profile photo.

- You may create a Twitter account at www.twitter.com.
- If you are not currently a Twitter user, you will need to install a Twitter client on your desktop or mobile device. It is the Twitter client which allows you to send "Tweets" and follow others on Twitter. The preferred Twitter client for this class is TweetDeck (<https://tweetdeck.twitter.com>).
- After completing the above steps, you should follow @CarlArgila. Please note that your instructor will not follow student accounts, however your classmates may follow you on Twitter.
- In order to receive full credit for this assignment "mention" @CarlArgila with hash-tag #CSC5 and include your name as it appears on the class roster. It is important that I be able to locate student Twitter accounts by name.
- You should acknowledge that you have read a #CSC5 Tweet by "liking" the Tweet. You may also wish to re-Tweet or respond to important information. When you "like" a #CSC5 Tweet I know that you have read that Tweet and that you are engaged with your class.
- Your participation on Twitter is considered part of your Class Participation grade.

Note: This assignment will count as a 15 point quiz. You will earn full credit by completing the above instructions by the assignment due date. No credit will be given for "egg accounts."
